2022 ANNUAL GIVING

We have heard from 65% of our Early Givers. A total of 32 families have committed \$266,296 for 30% of the \$900,000 goal for 2022.

These 32 leadership gifts represent just 5% of our 600 families while contributing 30% of our goal.

St. Andrew's 2021 Budget: \$1,010,094

Expenses at St. Andrew's can be categorized into one of six areas of ministry (listed below). Here are just a few examples of the many things each ministry pays for:

Traditional Payments

Pledge payments and other financial giving can be sent to the church by mail. Please indicate in the memo line of your check if your gift is for your pledge payment.

Automatic Withdrawal of Offerings (ACH)

Give Online with WeShare

Did you know you can pay your pledge or give a general offering to St. Andrew's online? Visit standrewsaa.weshareonline.org to set up recurring or one-time donations.

Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCD)




Have you filled out your 2022 Pledge Card?

When we join together in a common commitment the Church will thrive. Your pledge for the coming year will support the work of the church and make our ministries possible.

Please fill in your pledge information completely and legibly!

Make sure you fill in your name(s), current address, a signature, and your 2022 pledge amount.

Do you need offering envelopes?

If you use offering envelopes as your giving method please make sure you select 'I/We want offering envelopes' on your pledge card. Envelopes are only sent to those who request them and are mailed on a quarterly basis.

Are you giving with Automatic Bank Debit (ACH)?

If you use Automatic Bank Debit (ACH) as your payment method please make sure you fill out the 'ACH Giving Authorization' section. We need you

to re-authorize the transaction each year whether or not you are continuing your giving at the same rate.

How much should I give?



What if I need to change my pledge?
