

Organ Use Policy

Updated: March 4, 2022

1. Any and all practice times on either of the St. Andrew's Organs must be approved and scheduled by the Director of Music, in consultation with the Building Administrator, no exceptions.

Qualifications for said practice times are: preparation for a recital at St. Andrew's or preparation for a service at St. Andrew's.

Guests will only be permitted with special permission from the Director of Music.

2. Teaching privileges are given to the Director of Music. All other teaching requests are to be approved by the Director of Music.
3. All practice times will take place during normal business hours except by special arrangement through the Director of Music.
4. All persons with specified practice time permission must enter through the Memorial Garden entrance and check-in with the church office, and are asked to leave by checking out with the church office.
5. All memory levels will be assigned by the Director of Music.
6. No changes are to be made to any lighting or sound fixtures in the Church or the Chapel without permission.
7. Current St. Andrew's Covid protocols must be followed.
8. No food or drink is allowed in the Church.
9. St. Andrew's reserves the right to cancel previously scheduled rehearsal time if the church space is needed for an unforeseen event, such as a funeral.

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
