• After the procession in, photographers and videographers must remain behind the congregation at all times. Stationary, unmanned video cameras may be set up in two locations in the front of the church, as determined by the clergy. Manned video cameras may be set up in the balcony.	
• It is often helpful for the photographer/videographer to attend the rehearsal in order to get a sense of the building and the flow of the service	
 In the event of questions about these guidelines, the officiating clergy person has final say.
